Vision Principles --

1. Walkability

These Vision Principles can be applied to the following issues and projects:

1. Walkability -- Zoning, parking regulation, allowing for density around the train station, public education
2. Affordable Housing -- Zoning, education about this as a community value
3. Community Spaces -- Green spaces and public gathering places. Shift the focus to the station circle redesign, smartly designed; create a new community center; parklets (mini parks that temporarily occupy 2-3 parking spaces)
4. Resilient Community -- Adapting to the warmer and wetter climate, public education
5. Biking -- Bike lanes, public education, promotion of biking by the Borough; facilitate connection to non-Narberth biking corridors
6. Local participative democracy -- Engaging people of all ages, incomes, and family composition (via childcare for public events)
7. Aging in community -- sidewalk maintenance, transportation, ADA compliance for public spaces, availability of diverse housing opportunities, living spaces in accessory dwellings, promoting density
8. Leaner Borough budget -- through municipal waste reduction and energy use reduction
9. Environmentally Sustainability -- Mitigating greenhouse gas emissions in borough properties and vehicles, promoting mitigation by resident households and businesses, aiming for carbon neutrality, solar panels, public education
10. Vibrant downtown community -- Improve retail mix, create a town square in the Station Circle
