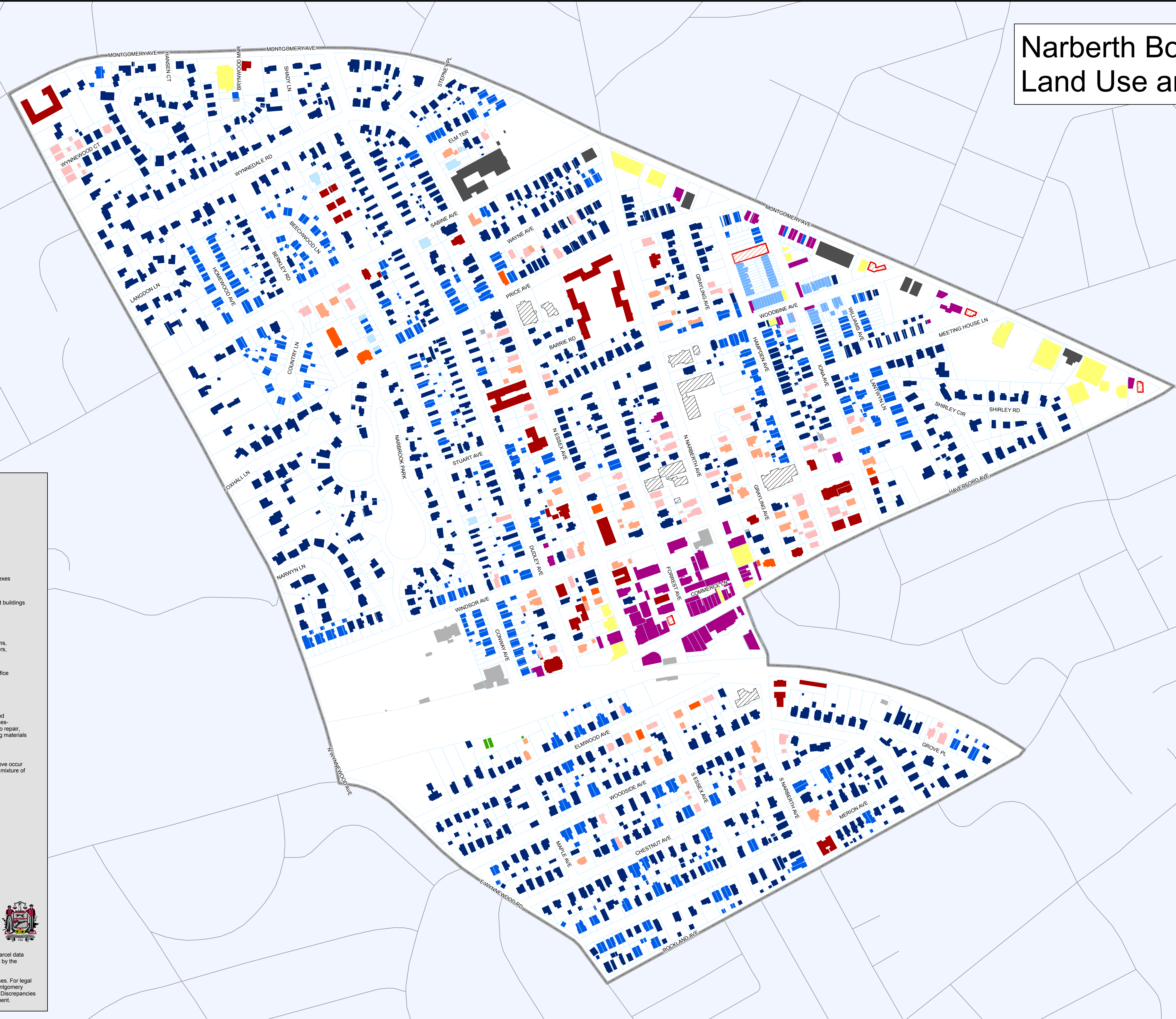

	Other retail uses	retail uses that usually demand separation from residential uses- gas stations, body shops, auto repair, recycling centers, and building materials

Mixed Use

buildings where more than one of the uses listed above occur in the same structure, in most every case involves a mixture of residential and nonresidential uses

Other

structures on parcels coded for nondeveloped areas

government, post office, transportation
